A minor

natural: A - B - C - D - E - F - G - A

harmonic: A - B - C - D - E - F - G sharp - A

melodic up: A - B - C - D - E - F sharp - G sharp - A; down uses natural form

E minor

natural: E - F sharp - G - A - B - C - D - E

harmonic: E - F sharp - G - A - B - C - D sharp - E

melodic up: E - F sharp - G - A - B - C sharp - D sharp - E; down uses natural form

B minor

natural: B - C sharp - D - E - F sharp - G - A - B

harmonic: B - C sharp - D - E - F sharp - G - A sharp - B

melodic up: B - C sharp - D - E - F sharp - G sharp - A sharp - B; down uses natural form

D minor

natural: D - E - F - G - A - B flat - C - D

harmonic: D - E - F - G - A - B flat - C sharp - D

melodic up: D - E - F - G - A - B - C sharp - D; down uses natural form

G minor

natural: G - A - B flat - C - D - E flat - F - G

harmonic: G - A - B flat - C - D - E flat - F sharp - G

melodic up: G - A - B flat - C - D - E - F sharp - G; down uses natural form

C minor

natural: C - D - E flat - F - G - A flat - B flat - C

harmonic: C - D - E flat - F - G - A flat - B - C

melodic up: C - D - E flat - F - G - A - B - C; down uses natural form
